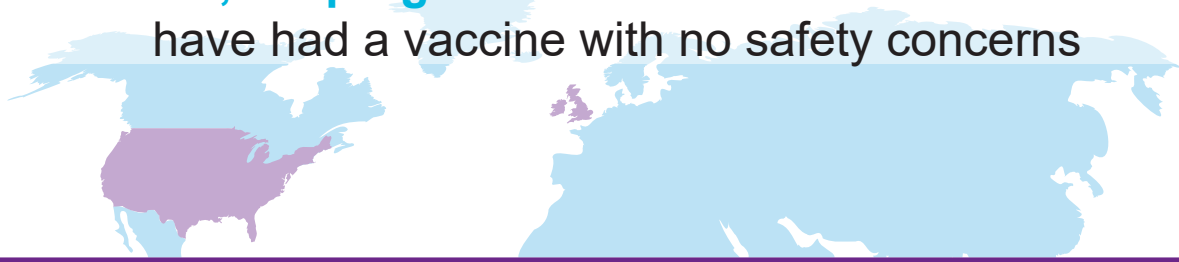

COVID-19 Vaccination is SAFE in pregnancy

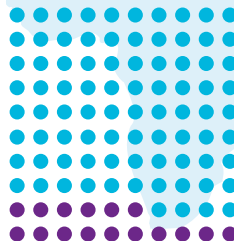
>270,000 pregnant women in the UK and USA have had a vaccine with no safety concerns



Right for Women

16 in 100

pregnant women in hospital with symptomatic COVID-19 are admitted to ITU



Right for Babies

Pregnant women with COVID-19 have:

2x increased risk of stillbirth

2x increased risk of pre-term birth

97% of pregnant/postpartum women with COVID-19 admitted to ITU since June 17th are unvaccinated



To improve vaccination rates in pregnancy the message from healthcare professionals needs to be consistent:

‘The COVID-19 vaccine is SAFE in pregnancy, it could save your life or that of your baby’
